1. General

1.1. Organizer

The German Championships in Powered Aerobatics categories Advanced and Unlimited are held by Deutscher Aeroclub e.V. represented by the Bundeskommission Motorflug. The host is the German Aerobatic Association (Deutscher Kunstflugverband e.V.) with the friendly support of Extra Aircraft.

1.2. Location

The venue is held at Dinslaken/Schwarze Heide airfield (EDLD).

1.3. Schedule

The competition will be held from July 5th thru July 9th. The preliminary schedule is:

5. July arrival and registration

5. July 18.00 LOC general briefing (compulsory)

6. - 8. July competition flights

8. July 19.00 LOC price giving and closing ceremony

9. July departure



2. Rules

2.1. General

The competition will be held in accordance with the FAI Sporting Code (valid for 2023) Section 6 Part 1 (Regulation for the conduct of international aerobatic events, https://www.civanews.com/the-civa-document-store/), unless otherwise described in this bulletin. Due to local conditions, further deviations are possible (e.g. it will be impossible to have a fully marked box due to local conditions). Any deviations will be announced as soon as possible.

By registration for the competition, the participants accept these rules. Likewise with the registration they acknowledge that the organizer as well as the host of the venue (including all persons commissioned by them) are not liable for property damage or personal injury incurred by the participation in the venue.

2.2. Participation in the competition

Participants must hold a valid pilot's license including aerobatic rating, a valid medical certificate and must have sufficient experience to safely conduct the competition flights in the respective category.

The aircraft used must be proven airworthy and certified for aerobatics. The aircraft's liability insurance must cover competition aerobatics. The performance data and operating limits of the aircraft must allow safe conduct of the competition flights in the respective category. Participants are required to comply with the operating limits of the aircraft

Compliance with the above requirements must be presented to the organizer prior to the first flight in the competition.

If the flying skills of participants or the performance data of the aircraft do not ensure a safe execution of the competition flights, the organizer is authorized to classify participants in a lower category or to exclude them completely from the competition for safety reasons. In this case the entry fee cannot be refunded.

International participants are welcome. However, they are not eligible for awards and the corresponding prizes, nor for the Gerd Mühlbauer Trophy.

2.3. Conduct of the competition

2.3.1. Categories

The competition will be conducted in the following categories

- Advanced
- Unlimited



2.3.2. Competition programs

Depending on the category, following programs will be flown

Program	Advanced	Unlimited
Program 1	Free Known	Free Known
Program 2	Comp. Unknown	Comp. Unknown
Program 3	Free Unknown	Free Unknown
Program 4		Final Freestyle

Compulsory Unknown (Prog. 2)

As Prog. 2 a Compulsory Unknown is flown, which is designed by an international coach according to the regulations of the valid FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1.

Free Unknown (Prog. 3)

As Prog. 3 a Free Unknown is flown according to the regulations of the valid FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1. For pilots who do not want to design their own program due to the tight schedule, the organizer will ensure a Default Unknown, which will be designed by an international coach.



2.3.3. Aerobatic box

There will be no line judges.

Location of the aerobatic box (approximately):



2.3.4. Time gap in between two competition flights

Rule 2.5.1.1 of the Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1 ("only one flight per competitor per day") does not apply. A minimum interval of 4 hours between two competition flights must be ensured.



2.4. Awards

In the German Aerobatic Championships there will be no gender-separated scoring and therefore no gender-specific titles or prizes will be awarded.

Titles and prizes will only be awarded if there are at least three competitors in a category.

The titles and prizes described in this section can only be awarded to German participants.

2.4.1. Titles

- ► The highest scoring competitor in programs 1-3 in the category Unlimited will be awarded with the title "German Aerobatic Champion 2023"
- ► The highest scoring competitor in program 4 in the category Unlimited acquires the title "German Freestyle Aerobatic Champion 2023"
- ► The highest scoring competitor in programs 1-3 in the category Advanced will be awarded with the title "Winner Category Advanced 2023"

2.4.2. Prizes and trophies

- ► Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in each category.
- ► The highest scoring competitor in each category will receive the **Gerd****Mühlbauer Trophy* of the respective category. This is related with a sport's promotion prize.



3. Registration

3.1. Registration

Registration is open from now on and is only possible online at https://kunstflugverband.de/wettbewerbe/2023/dm-adv-unl-dinslaken/.

Deadline for registration is June 28, 2023. Participation will only be confirmed after full receipt of the entry fee.

3.2. Entry Fee

The entry fee covers the organization costs only. Other costs, such as for fuel, oil, landing and parking fees are to be settled on site.

The entry fee is:

- For registration until May 31st 2023: 280 €
- For registration until June 28th 2023: 330 €

Refund of the entry fee in case of cancellation by the participant is only possible until May 31st 2023

The payment will be either done by direct debit or by bank transfer. Members of the DKuV can declare their agreement during the online registration that the existing SEPA direct debit mandate can also be used for the collection of the entry fee. Non-members of the DKuV can download a SEPA direct debit mandate at https://kunstflugverband.de/files/verband/DKuV-SEPA-Nenngelder.pdf and send it parallel to the registration to finanzen@kunstflugverband.de.
